We help relieve pain, manage symptoms, and provide emotional and spiritual support for the entire family. Our team consists of physicians, nurses, a chaplain, child life specialist,

music therapist, massage therapist and social worker. Established in 1995, we are the only hospice program in central Ohio exclusively focused on meeting the needs of children.

Palliative Care

Our Palliative Care program provides the same life-enriching services to children living with lifelimiting illnesses, sometimes for years. We focus
