That is why Nationwide Children's Hospital offers Hospice and Palliative Care Services to children with serious illnesses, and their families.

Hospice

Children facing end of life are first and foremost children– children who want to play, laugh, and be home where they are surrounded by family and friends. Nationwide Children's Hospital's Hospice Program helps these kids be kids by providing life-enriching care in the comfort of their own home, or in the hospital when needed. We help relieve pain, manage symptoms, and provide emotional and spiritual support for the entire family. Our team consists of physicians, nurses, a chaplain, child life specialist, music therapist, massage therapist and social worker. Established in 1995, we are the only hospice program in central Ohio exclusively focused on meeting the needs of children.

Palliative Care

Our Palliative Care program provides the same life-enriching services to children living with life-limiting illnesses, sometimes for years. We focus on minimizing the impact of an illness on a child's quality of life by providing relief of pain and other symptoms through our comprehensive set of offerings. Our program helps families provide their child the fullest and most comfortable life possible.

These programs embody the family-centered care model pioneered by Nationwide Children's Hospital. Because our mission is to provide the highest quality of care to all children and their families regardless of ability to pay, we depend on the goodwill and generosity of our community. Every dollar raised by the Butterfly Guild helps cover the uncompensated expenses provided by these programs.
